Deckchair

Folding chair with a fabric sling that acts as the seat and back rest. The back angle is adjustable and some designs feature armrests and/or leg rests.



Recliner

Folding reclining chair with a light metal frame and a fabric or mesh sling. Can be adjusted from upright chair to recliner; folds flat for storage.



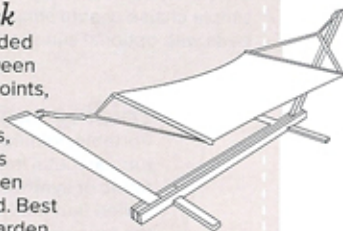
Traditional sunbed

Bed-style lounger made of wood or woven material. Has an adjustable upper section, wheels for easy manoeuvrability and usually cushions, too.



Hammock

Sling suspended by rope between two anchor points, traditionally trees or posts, but nowadays often a wooden support stand. Best for a larger garden.



Fixed

Full-length contoured lounger made of woven materials such as wicker, rattan or nylon mesh. Often with wheels for easy manoeuvrability.



Adirondack

Wooden armchair originating from America (the Adirondack Mountains) with a slatted back, angled seat and wide, flat armrests.
